We believe that there is one God¹, eternally existent² in three persons: Father³, Son⁴, and Holy Spirit⁵.

JESUS

We believe in the deity of our Lord Jesus Christ¹, in his virgin birth², sinless life³, miracles⁴, vicarious and atoning death through his shed blood⁵, bodily resurrection⁶, ascension to the right hand of the Father⁷, and personal return in power and glory⁸.

HOLY SPIRIT

We believe in the present ministry of the Holy Spirit¹, by whose indwelling² the Christian is enabled to live a godly life³.

HUMANITY

We believe that Adam, created in the image of God¹, was tempted by Satan² and fell³. Because of Adam's sin, all humans are guilty and totally depraved⁴.

We believe that for the salvation of lost and sinful people, regeneration by the Holy Spirit is essential⁵.

SALVATION

We believe that salvation consists of the remission of sins¹, the imputation of Christ's righteousness², and the gift of eternal life³, received by faith alone, apart from works⁴.

We believe in the resurrection of both the saved and the lost⁵: those saved unto eternal life⁶, and those lost unto eternal damnation⁷.

THE CHURCH

We believe that the church, the body of Christ, consists only of those who are born again¹, baptized by the Holy Spirit into Christ², for whom he now makes intercession in heaven³, and for whom he will come again⁴.

We believe in the spiritual unity of believers in our Lord Jesus Christ⁵.

EVANGELISM AND MISSIONS

We believe that Christ commanded the church to go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature¹, baptizing and teaching those who believe².

We believe that the natural outcome of such activity leads to the establishment of local congregations³.

THE CHRISTIAN AND SOCIETY

We believe all Christians are under obligation to make the will of Christ supreme in our own lives and in human society¹. In the spirit of Christ, Christians should oppose racism, greed, selfishness, vice, and all forms of sexual immorality, including adultery, homosexuality, and pornography². We should work to provide for the orphaned, needy, abused, aged, helpless, and sick³, and contend for the sanctity of all human life from conception to natural death⁴.
