**A need to understand how our Western missiology has been shaped by anthropology and sociology, and especially by management presuppositions**

- Moves us from God's organic mission to a variety of managerial missiology.
- We are finishing the job by re-measuring the task remaining.
- Recover "all nations" as more inclusive understanding than only unreached people groups.

**In the Global South we discover a mission movement driven more by the local church or denomination and less by the agencies.**

- Disconnection between the church and missions structures is the major obstacle for advance in missions
- "Transformación de la Iglesia" program
- Helps the church to become effective in discipling process for multiplying disciples to be sent to the nations
